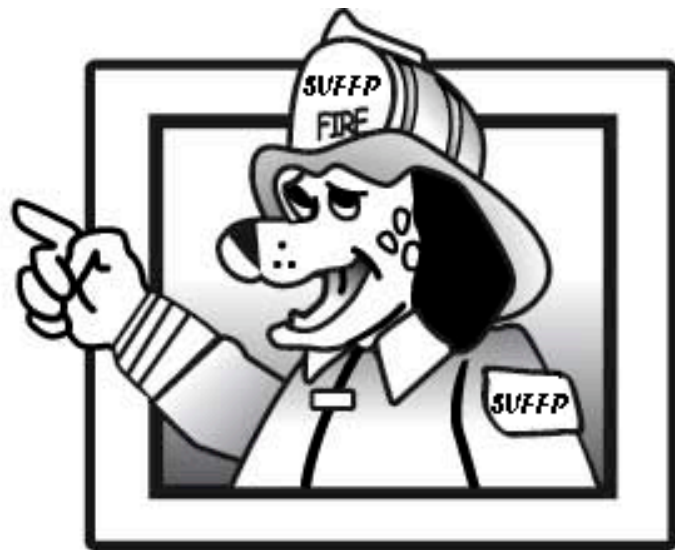

Sacramento Valley Firesetters Program
would like you to take a tour of your home and use this checklist to see
how safe your household is.

In the Living Areas:

- _____ The fireplace has a sturdy screen.
- _____ Portable heaters and other heaters are at least 3 feet from anything that can burn.
- _____ All candles are in sturdy bases placed up high and are never left unattended while burning.
- _____ Matches and lighters are kept up high in a locked cabinet, out of the sight of children.

In the Kitchen:

- _____ Cooking is never left unattended.
- _____ There is always a pan lid within easy reach should a fire start. Should a fire break out, turn off the burner and carefully put the lid on the pan.
- _____ Tight fitting sleeves are always worn during meal preparations; loose clothes can easily catch fire.
- _____ A fire extinguisher is always available if necessary.
- _____ When cooking, pot handles are always turned outward for easy access.

In the Hallway/Bedroom:

- _____ All smoke detectors are checked monthly.
- _____ All smoke detector batteries are changed at least once a year.
- _____ Space heaters are kept at least 3 feet from anything that can burn.

Escaping A Fire:

- _____ The family has a home escape plan and practices it twice a year.
- _____ All family members know two ways out of every room.
- _____ If you have security bars on your windows, do you have quick-release devices?
